Evenings open air

Based on space and astronomical news, the Open Sky evenings allow everyone, young or old, to increase their scientific knowledge, but also to discover how to observe the sky with the naked eye and through a telescope.

Open-air evenings are suitable for all levels of knowledge.

The entertainment program is defined according to the weather conditions, the possible theme of the evening, the ephemeris... You can attend a planetarium session on certain evenings, observe the Moon, understand the phenomenon of the seasons thanks to the gnomon, learn to spot the main constellations of the northern hemisphere sky...



Activities for everyone

The Astrorama also offers activities for the “general public” during the day or in the evening, as well as introductory courses in astronomy for children.

- “Initiation to Observation” evenings from 6 years old.
- “Shows to the Stars” evenings from 6 or 12 years old depending on the evening.
- Wednesday Astro Meetings from 12 years old.
- Days “between heaven and earth”.
- Astro Sundays.





Panorama exceptional

The Astrorama is located on the heights of the Col d'Èze at an altitude of 650 meters, in the Parc de la Grande Cornice. This place dedicated to scientific mediation, offers an exceptional panorama on the coast, from Cap Ferrat to the Lérins Islands.



Schedule

The “Open Skies” evenings last 4 hours: From April to October:

- from 7 p.m. to 11 p.m.

From November to March:

- from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.

A small 30-minute break in the middle of the evening is organized so that participants can eat, either with their own picnic or in ordering sandwiches when booking.

- Students:9.50 euros.
