

Rose centifolia, jasmine, tuberose, lavender, geranium, broom, orange tree... perfumes are first born in plants, from here or elsewhere.



The botanical garden interactive

Enjoy an interactive ride as you venture into the plots to touch the flowers and their foliage. For each species, a panel explains the history, origin and use of the species in perfumery. Live this experience as if you were choosing the fragrances of your new perfume.




Visit olfactory

The plants in the MIP garden are classified by olfactory zones: floral, woody, fruity, spicy or herbaceous note... Along the way, approach each plot to smell its different smells while passing your hand through the plants. The different species serve as inspiration for the perfumer, and are used in essence in perfumes.

A haven for animals and insects

Thanks to its plants, the MIP garden allows animals to live there. A multitude of species cohabit such as bees, dragonflies or butterflies. Birds also have their place here.

You will be able to observe blue tits, or even doves. The canal that divides the garden in two, is home to a rich biodiversity: amphibians, reptiles...


