Steps of manufacturing

The museum makes you discover and understand the steps necessary to make a fragrance: the harvest of flowers, the treatment of materials first, and finally the finished product. Learn the different techniques used by perfumers to create quality perfumes.



Recreational activities and educational

Various cultural and recreational activities are offered to extend your experience. The Museum offers:

- An introduction to perfumery, including a guided tour and a workshop.
- A theme day: one Saturday per month, discover a perfume plant during a visit accompanied by the gardener and the perfumer.
- Writing workshops.

The collection permed

The MIP has more than 50,000 objects from the 5 continents. Admire decorative objects, works of art or simple everyday objects. There are 5,000 years of perfumery history to discover. In particular, find Queen Marie-Antoinette's travel kit, old perfume bottles, posters, and Jean Carles' perfume organ. The museum completes its collection with temporary exhibitions.





Visits-workshops playful

Several types of visit-workshops are offered with different themes to appeal to children and adults.

A treasure hunt is offered to children in order to discover in a fun way the history of perfumes through civilizations.

For older children, solve puzzles on the history of perfumery during a "Serious Game". Take an inter-museum tour between the perfumery museum and the museum of art and history of Provence.

- From July 01 to August 31: from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- From September 01 to June 30: from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. The ticket office closes one hour before the museum closes.

The museum is closed on May 1, December 25 and January 1.
