


TRIBUTE TO PICASSO

50 years since Picasso's death!



The inauguration this May 6 Ballet Flamenco of Andalusia...

In opening, will take place on the place of the release, the concert of opening of the philharmonic orchestra of Antibes and the harmony of Vallauris. At 10:30 am at the Magnelli Museum, attend the inauguration of the Picasso, Forms and Metamorphoses exhibition. The afternoon will be devoted to paying tribute to the children, with performances of song, dance, slam and poetry. At 8:30 p.m. at the Théâtre de la Mer, flamenco dancers from Andalucia pay homage to the artist's Spanish origins.



May 7 festivities Fanfare, show, dance

At 10 a.m., the festivities begin. On the program, Banda fanfare, a musical and artistic parade from Square Nabonnand to Pablo Picasso beach to celebrate the new name of the Plage du Soleil. From 5 p.m. to 7.15 p.m., the Fantagaro stable will introduce you to the art of equestrian dressage and vaulting. Observe the synergy between a rider and his mount. At 9:30 p.m., the town of Vallauris organizes projections on the facade of the Sainte-Anne church, a real sound and light show.

"Forms and Metamorphoses" exhibition From May 6 to October 30

At the Magnelli Museum, discover the Picasso exhibition "Forms and metamorphoses: ceramic creation". Temple of pottery, Picasso devotes himself to the different techniques of this art.

It produces thousands of colorful ceramic pieces.

This Exhibition retraces the work of the artist and

pays homage to him.





Exhibition "Picasso and Goldsmithing" From June 24 to October 25

This exhibition, at the Magnelli Museum, retraces the collaboration between Pablo Picasso and the goldsmith François Hugo, great-grandson of Victor Hugo. Discover how Picasso transposes goldsmithing to the art of ceramics. The exhibition is accompanied by a series of photographs and archival documents from the time.

Schedule


The Magnelli Museum is open every day, except Tuesdays.
