


Many other objects are to be discovered: sports equipment, posters, objects, archives...





Immersive tours and interactive

The visit of the national sports museum is animated by 4 immersive spaces: Training, the Greatest Moments of Sport, Football, Adventure. Observe the champions: Tony Parker, Rafael Nadal or Roger Federer through interviews or mini-films. Rediscover the finest sporting achievements and discover thrilling adventures around the world.

Temporary exhibitions from April 6 to September 17, 2023

The exhibition "Victoires" in collaboration with the Louvre Museum, is held from April 6 to September 17, 2023. The exhibition focuses on the Olympic Games of ancient Greece. Looking ahead to Paris 2024, discover 28 ancient works, sculptures and paintings on loan from the Parisian museum.

The museum is open: From

June to August:


• Every day from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

From September to June:

• Tuesday to Sunday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The museum is closed on December 25, January 1 and May 1.

On match days at the Allianz Riviera, the museum closes one hour before the match kicks off.



Prices

Prices for the permanent exhibition or the temporary exhibition:

- Adult :16 euros.
- Reduced:3 euros.

Prices for both exhibitions:

- Adult :8 euros.
- Reduced:4 euros.

Tours are free for people under 18.

Guided tours of the stadium and an exhibition:

- Adult :16 euros.
- Person under 18:10 euros.

This combined visit is free for children under 5 years old.
