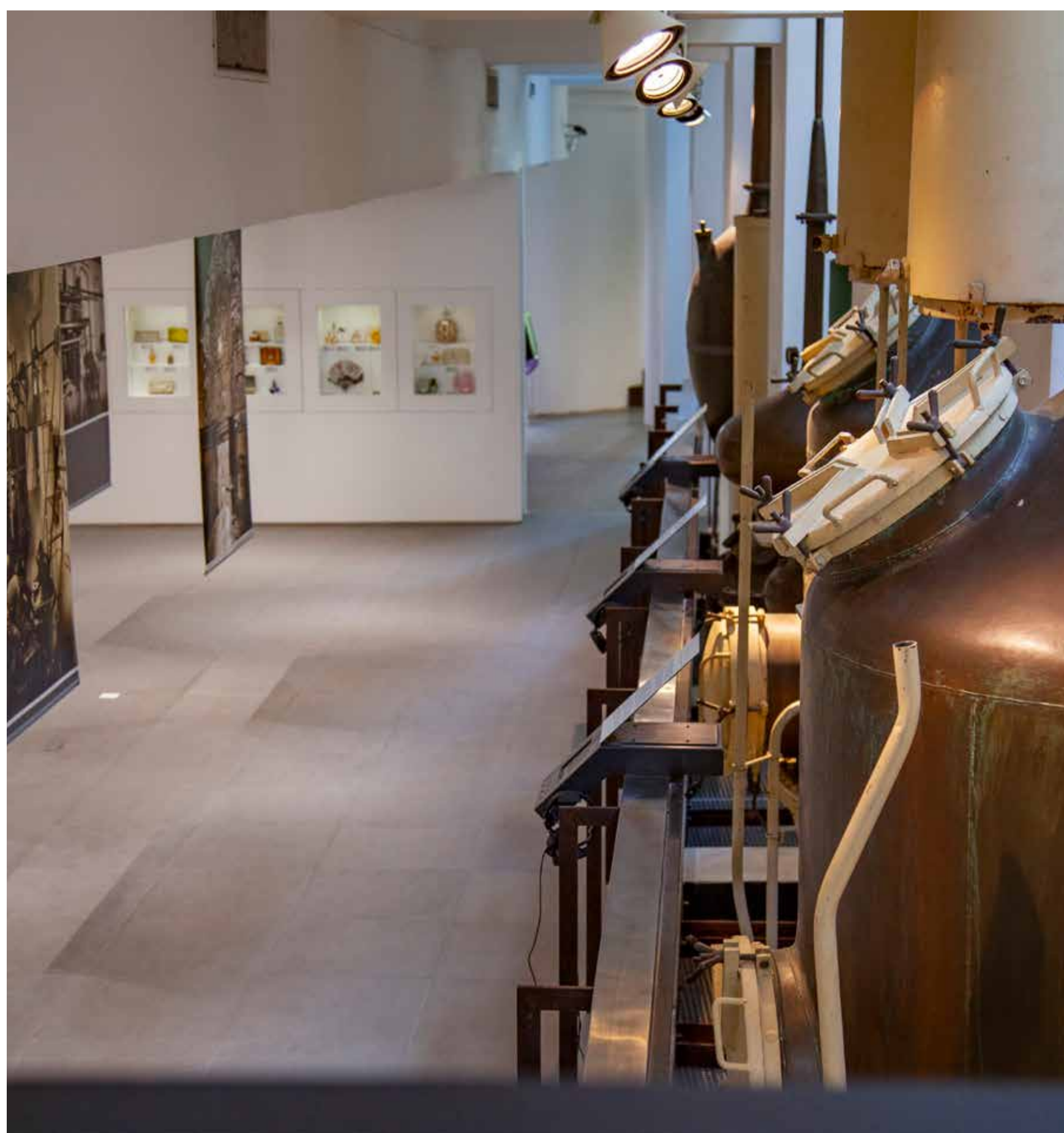

The steps of manufacturing

The museum helps you discover and understand the steps involved in creating a fragrance: harvesting the flowers, processing the raw materials from the initial stages, and finally the finished product, including the art of bottling... Learn the different techniques used by perfumers to create quality perfumes.



Fun activities and educational

Various cultural and recreational activities allow you to extend your experience.

The Museum offers you:

- An introduction to perfumery, including a guided tour and a workshop.
- Writing workshops.



The collection permed

The MIP boasts over 50,000 objects from five continents. Admire works of art, decorative art objects, and items used in the industrial production of perfumes, illustrating 5,000 years of perfume history. Highlights include Queen Marie Antoinette's travel kit, antique perfume bottles, posters, and Jean Carles' perfume organ. The museum also presents temporary exhibitions to complement its collection.





Workshop visits playful

Several types of workshop visits are offered with different themes to appeal to children and adults.

A treasure hunt is offered to the children in order to discover the history of perfumes across civilizations in a fun way.

For older children, solve puzzles about the history of perfumery during a "Serious Game". Take an inter-museum tour between the Perfume Museum and the Museum of Art and History of Provence.

Schedules

The Museum is open:

- From July 1st to August 31st: from 10am to 7pm.
- From September 1st to June 30th: From 10am to 6pm. The ticket office closes one hour before the museum closes.

The museum is closed on the 1st of May, December 25th and 1st of January.

The museum is closed on the first Monday of the month.

January, February, March, October, November and December.
